United Faculty Announces Faculty Award Winners

Two win Above and Beyond Awards for exemplary non-tenure track faculty

Cedar Falls, Iowa – United Faculty, the faculty labor union at the University of Northern Iowa, awarded two Above and Beyond Awards, worth \$1000 each, in honor of exemplary non-tenure track faculty members. The 2025 winners:

- Amanda Barr, Assistant Adjunct Professor from the Department of Art, has been teaching ceramics and foundations art courses such as drawing and 3-D concepts at UNI for three years. In that time, she has shown exceptional leadership, especially with the ceramics program and the essential operations of the studio, such as mixing clay, glazes, firing and overseeing kilns, and ensuring student safety.
- **Kimberly Mashek**, Adjunct Faculty Member, Rod Library, has worked at UNI since 2021. Mashek is recognized for her outstanding librarianship work. She initiated and developed a new, self-paced, asynchronous topics course, BUS 3000: Digital and Data Literacy. This course, created in collaboration with Wilson College of Business (WCOB), helps students work toward a

Data and Digital Literacy badge that Mashek also developed. Mashek conceived of the course in her role as a business liaison librarian, to address unmet needs and support student skill development as well as college accreditation.
